## Intern Job Description

Intern's primary responsibility is to work with elementary students participating in a multi-visit garden program as well as assisting with Saturday family programs. Programs are based in the Children's Garden, with vegetable beds, butterfly garden, sensory garden, orchard and a California Natives garden. Intern will also be responsible for basic garden maintenance.

## Responsibilities

- \*March-May prepare and present hands-on gardening, environmental education, and nature craft activities for children ages 5 – 12 in the Children's Garden.
- \*Assist with maintenance of Children's Garden - water, weed, plant.
- \*Assist with our Saturday Family Bean Sprouts Program from April-May.
- \*Work with Children's Garden Educator, another intern, teachers and parent volunteers to handle daily logistics.

## Qualifications

- \*Ability to work with a diverse urban population.
- \*Previous experience working with children ages 5 - 12.
- \*Gardening experience helpful.
- \*Dependability and self-confidence essential.

## Work Schedule

20 hours per week, March to May. Must be available March-May during program hours, Monday through Thursday, 9:00-1:00, as well as Saturdays 12:30-4:30 pm, April 1 through May 20, for our family Bean Sprouts program. Possibility of summer employment as well.
